

2021 – 2022 REGISTRATION INFORMATION

Registration

Online registration will open on Wednesday September 8th at www.capshockey.ca. The minor hockey office will open Tuesday September 7th to assist with registration. Office hours are Monday through Friday 9:00 AM to 12:00 PM. To minimize congestion in the office area we ask that you call ahead and make an appointment. All players must be registered by September 30th. If players register after that date we cannot guarantee we will be able to accommodate the player.

Respect in Sport Parent Course

The Respect in Sport Parent Course is required to register your child to play minor hockey. Without a course completion certificate number we will not be able to register your child. Only 1 parent per family need complete the course and parents who previously completed the course do not have to recomplete it. Follow the Respect in Sport link on our home page www.capshockey.ca. Remember to enter St. John's Minor Hockey as your Association when registering.

Don Johnson Hockey League ("DJHL") www.djhl.ca.

Players interested in trying out for the DJHL AA Pooled leagues must register directly with the DJHL before August 31st, 2021. New in 2021/2022 is a Female Under 13 A division. Players registered for the DJHL tryout can find further information (cost, dates, times and locations) through the league website.

SJMHA Association Based A and B Teams

This season we plan to operate Under 11 A, Under 11 B, Under 13 A and Under 15 A teams in the DJHL. Tryouts for the Under 11 A, Under 11 B, Under 13 A and Under 15 A teams will take place over the October 9th to October 17th time period. The dates for the Under 13 A and Under 15 A tryouts will take place after the DJHL tryouts. Players who are released from the DJHL tryouts and subsequently return to try out for the Under 13 A and Under 15 A teams must also pay the appropriate tryout and registration fees to SJMHA.

U7/U9 Hockey

Last season COVID restrictions did not allow SJMHA to operate its Initiation Program, as a result there could be low numbers of players registering to play U7 hockey. If that is the case, SJMHA may have to combine the U7 and U9 programs into a multi-tiered U9 program based on player skill. This will become evident after registration is completed.

U18 Hockey

In seasons prior to the 2020/2021 season Midget or U18 players had a choice of playing in the SJMHA midget house league or in the Doug Marshall Hockey League ("DMHL"), in addition to high school hockey. Last season the DMHL did not operate, and there are currently no plans to restart the league this season. Caps U18 players can play both U18 house league and high school hockey.

Female Hockey

For 2021/2022 the female hockey program has changed age groups. Female hockey will follow the U9, U11, U13, U15 and U18 age group model similar to Minor Hockey. New this season is a pilot project for a U13 Female Pooled A Division in the DJHL. The female program also offers competitive hockey at the AA and AAA provincial levels. Players interested in female hockey must register with SJMHA, with the exception of those who play in the DJHL.
